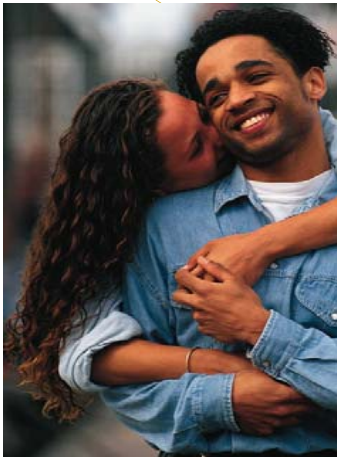
Indianapolis Substance Abuse Services

CASI provides substance abuse services to individuals between 11 and 75 years of age as well as their families. Our services are evidence-based and best practices. Services are designed to engage clients and their families in treatment and the recovery process.

We have specialized programming for men, women, and adolescents, as well as Spanish-speaking individuals. We also treat HIV positive individuals for substance abuse issues.

In addition to substance abuse, we are certified to treat gambling addictions. Our goal is to help clients lead a

healthy physical and emotional life. Through family involvement we assist people with changing behaviors and improving relationships.



Hamilton County Substance Abuse Services

Hamilton County Substance Abuse Services were developed specifically in response to the needs of Hamilton County residents. Emphasis is on improving behaviors and family relationships. The mix of services over the years has been refined to meet the needs of working families in Hamilton County, with the majority of the services being provided in the evenings.

We focus on engaging individuals and family members in treatment and the recovery process. We promote healthy choices for individuals regarding substance abuse with the goal of emotional well being and healthy family relationships.

CASI is a Hoosier Assurance Plan provider and member agency of United Way of Central Indiana. This enables us to offer services on a sliding fee scale based on family income.

Prevention of substance abuse has been the cornerstone upon which our programs are built. Teaching Tae Kwon Do classes at a low cost offers an alternative approach to learn effective solutions for dealing with issues confronting children and teens in today's society.



Substance abuse and gang violence prevention is an integral part of the message presented at the Club. Tae Kwon Do, and its philosophy, are an effective tool in making a positive difference in the lives of young people. Participants learn the philosophy of martial arts:
